WHAT IS THE STREETSBORO EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION?

The Streetsboro City Schools' Educational Foundation was founded in 1998 as a partnership of business, education, and community members committed to promoting academic excellence by providing additional resources and opportunities for improving the quality of education in this school system. The Foundation's grants are designed to expand horizons for students and encourage community involvement in the education process. Initial funding for the Foundation was made possible by various community donations, and the Foundation actively participates in increasing and maintaining this fund to perpetuate distributions. The Foundation is a tax exempt, charitable organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, and therefore, all donations are tax-deductible to the fullest extent of the law. Income generated from donations is available for distribution for worthwhile, non-required school programs.

WHAT KIND OF PROJECTS DOES THE STREETSBORO FOUNDATION SUPPORT?

Funds are available to support educational initiatives that explore new and innovative frontiers in public school education in Streetsboro. Priority will be given to projects that promote parent and community interaction to enhance the learning process.

PROPOSALS FOR PROJECTS MAY FOCUS ON, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO:

- 1) Improving academic skills of students.
- 2) Broadening cooperation between community and school.
- 3) Involving parents in the teaching/learning process.
- 4) Enhancing the teaching/learning process through the use of community resources.
- 5) Testing ideas that are designed to improve instruction.
- 6) Professional development.
- 7) Programs that encourage learning throughout the entire calendar year.

WHAT FORM SHOULD A PROPOSAL TAKE?

You may complete this form online and then print it. Do not use report covers, binders, or folders. Any additional information included to support a proposal and provided for reference to the Foundation shall also conform to standard paper size for distribution. Please submit 10 copies of all necessary information. All signatures are required. Grant proposals are to be submitted to Joe Huber, who will submit the proposals to the board.

WHAT WILL NOT BE FUNDED?

Grants may not be used to pay for:

- 1) Capital improvements.
- 2) Purchase of classroom materials and supplies not directly related to the project or those normally funded by the school or district.
- 3) Athletics.
- 4) Projects that have specific funding available through other established means.
- 5) Programs that benefit teachers only and not students:

WHAT QUESTIONS SHOULD THE PROPOSAL ANSWER?

- 1) How will this project promote academic excellence and improve the quality of education in the Streetsboro School system?
- 2) How is the project original or innovative?
- 3) What are the immediate and long-term objectives?
- 4) How will the project be evaluated?
- 5) How will the results be disseminated to others, especially back to the Foundation?
- 6) What are the plans for continuing a successful grant project when its funds are exhausted? '
- 7) What background reading, research, and/ or experience do the grant writers have that will help them implement this project?
- 8) How does this proposal support the district curriculum/strategic plan?

HOW ARE PROPOSALS CONSIDERED?

The amount of available funds to be distributed will be established by the Foundation. While there is no limit to amounts requested, an expensive proposal may be refused simply for lack of available funding. Funding will be divided to accommodate three submission dates. Notification of these submission dates will be given by e-mail. Applicants will be notified of the Board's decision by e-mail.
